

GENESEO CENTRAL SCHOOL
REGULATIONS FOR THE USE OF THE SWIMMING POOL

1. A qualified lifeguard must be present on the deck at all times. A qualified lifeguard shall mean an individual possessing as minimum qualifications current lifeguarding and Cardiopulmonary resuscitation for the professional Rescuer (CPRFPR) certificates from the American Red Cross or equivalent certifying agency on the basis of standards approved by the State Commissioner of Health, except that in jurisdictions where the permit-issuing official has adopted minimum qualifications for lifeguards, approved by the State Commission of Health, the term qualified lifeguard shall mean an individual certified by such permit-issuing official as possessing those qualifications.
2. The person or persons who shall act as lifeguards shall show to the Pool Director or the Athletic Director an original copy of their qualifications to perform the job.
3. Enough staff and supervisory personnel must be present to guarantee one (1) qualified supervisor for every twenty (20) swimmers or portion thereof.
4. Supervision of the locker room must be available during time in use by swimmers.
5. All swimmers must shower prior to entering the pool. Any potential swimmers that have a known illness, open sore etc., should not use the pool. Band-Aids need to be removed prior to swimming.
6. There must be controlled use of the showers including turning them off immediately after use.
7. The person in charge is responsible to see that everyone is out of the pool and locker room, see that pool doors (outside and inside) are locked and secure, lights are out and all equipment returned.
8. The time period allotted to a group includes the total amount of time for dressing, swimming and clearing the locker room.
9. All posted pool regulations must be adhered to.
10. Shoes are not to be worn in the pool area.
11. No cut-off shorts are allowed in the water. Swimsuits are to be worn.
12. Insuring the proper use of equipment and facilities is a prime responsibility of the person in charge.
13. Failure to comply with all regulations will result in the loss of the use of the facilities.
14. The person in charge must know the procedures for the district Emergency Action Plan (EAP).
