

# Legal Notice

TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE GENESEO CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT,  
Livingston County, New York:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the annual meeting (vote) of the qualified voters of the Geneseo Central School District, Livingston County, New York, will be held in said District on Tuesday, May 21, 2019 between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. prevailing time, at which time the polls will be open to vote upon the following propositions:

## **SEATS ON THE GENESEO CENTRAL SCHOOL BOARD OF EDUCATION**

To elect two Board of Education members to the Geneseo School Board of Education. There are two (2) three-year term seats to be filled, presently held by Michael Tenalio and Craig Phelps.

## **PROPOSITION NO. 1**

To adopt the annual budget of the School District of the fiscal year 2019 - 2020 and to authorize the requisite portion thereof to be raised by taxation on the taxable property of the District.

## **PROPOSITION NO. 2**

Shall the Board of Education of the Geneseo Central School District, Livingston County, New York be authorized to purchase one 66-passenger school bus, at an estimated maximum cost of \$134,897, and one 30-passenger school bus, at an estimated maximum cost of \$74,471, for a total aggregate maximum cost of \$209,368, with such cost to be raised by a tax upon the taxable property within said District to be levied and collected in annual installments in such years and in such amounts as may be determined by the Board of Education, with such tax to be partially offset by State Aid available therefor, and in anticipation of the collection of such tax, by the issuance of debt obligations of the District or installment purchase contracts as may be necessary?

## **PROPOSITION NO. 3**

Shall the Board of Education of the Geneseo Central School District, Livingston County, New York be authorized to expend \$25,000 from the District's existing Equipment Reserve Fund to pay the costs of (i) acquiring and installing weight training, physical education, and cardio fitness equipment in the fitness room at a maximum cost of \$10,000, and (ii) acquiring new technology hardware at a maximum cost of \$15,000?

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a copy of the statement of the amount of money which will be required to fund the School District's budget for the 2019-2020 school year, exclusive of public monies, and the tax exemption report may be obtained by any resident of the District at said Central School Building during the fourteen (14) days immediately preceding said Annual Meeting between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., except Saturday, Sunday and holidays. Copies of the said statement may also be obtained at the Annual Meeting.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that petitions nominating candidates for the office of member of the Board of Education shall be filed with the District Clerk of said School District at her office in the Geneseo Central School District Office, no later than Monday, April 22, 2019 between 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Each petition shall be directed to the Clerk of the District and shall be signed by at least twenty-five (25) voters of the District, and must state the name and residence of each signer.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that applications for absentee ballots for voting on the above-referenced propositions may be applied for at the office of the District Clerk, 4050 Avon Road, Geneseo, New York 14454. Any such application must be received by the District Clerk at least seven (7) days before the date of the vote on the above-referenced propositions if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before such vote if the ballot is to be picked up personally by the voter. A list of all persons to whom absentee ballots shall have been issued will be available for public inspection during regular business hours in the office of the District Clerk through the date of the election. Absentee ballots must be received in the office of the District Clerk not later than 5:00 p.m. on May 21, 2019. Any qualified voter present in the polling place may object to the voting of the ballot upon appropriate grounds for making his/her challenge and the reasons therefore known to the Inspector of Election before the close of the polls.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the qualified voters of the School District shall be entitled to vote at said annual vote and election. A qualified voter is one who is (1) a citizen of the United States of America, (2) eighteen years of age or older, and (3) a resident within the School District for a period of thirty (30) days preceding the annual vote and election. The School District may require all persons offering to vote at the budget vote and election to provide one form of proof of residency pursuant to Education Law S2019-C. Such form may include a driver's license, a non-driver identification card, a utility bill, or a voter registration card. Upon offer of proof of residency, the School District may also require all persons offering to vote to provide their signature, printed name and address.
