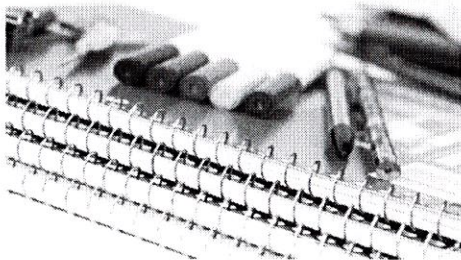
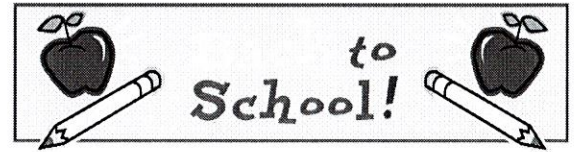


# Supply List for 7<sup>th</sup> Grade 2020-21

## General Supplies

- Pencils and pens
- 1 durable 2 pocket folder to be used as a homework folder to carry homework back and forth to school
- 1 highlighter (your preference of color)
- 1 set of colored pencils, crayons, or markers (your preference)

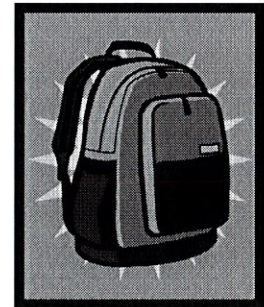


## English Supplies (Ms. Randall)

- One 2-pocket folder

## Social Studies (Mrs. Prinzi)

- One 2-pocket folder



## Science Supplies (Mrs. Stevenson)

- One green 2-pocket folder

## Math (Mr. Baer)

- One 1 inch black 3 ring binder
- **OPTIONAL** - TI-34 II scientific calculator (\$15), \*Ti-NSpire CX graphing calculator (\$130 to \$150), or Ti-84 Plus Graphing Calculator (\$90).



I know the graphing calculators are expensive, but it will be used every day in class, for homework, and on most of your local and state exams for the next 5 years. Three Regents Exams in math now require the use of a graphing calculator. The math department is phasing out of the TI-84s and is moving toward the \*Ti-NSpire CX. Having your own and knowing how to use it in 7<sup>th</sup> grade helps you become more proficient in high school. The school can supply calculators for in-class use only. You will not be able to sign a calculator out for homework, however a simple calculator with scientific notation such as that on any cell phone will be enough for most homework assignments.

## Spanish Supplies (Mrs. Coleman)

- 1" white 3-ring binder
- 1 pack of lined paper
- 1 dry erase marker
- 10 page protectors (NOT dividers)

## French Supplies (Mrs. Dwyer)

- 1" white 3 ring binder (with 12 dividers)
- 1 dry erase marker
- 1 pack of lined paper

The purpose of the notebook colors suggested above is to help students stay organized and to help them get their materials out of their lockers more quickly in between classes. It would be a great idea to label your binders and folders with your name, subject and grade level in permanent marker.
